STATEMENT ISSUED BY THE AFM INTERNATIONAL PRESIDENTS' SUMMIT ON 25 FEBRUARY 2022 ON THE TENSION BETWEEN RUSSIA AND UKRAINE

Leaders of the Apostolic Faith Mission attending the AFM International Presidents' Summit expressed grave concerns on the current hostilities that have developed between Russia and Ukraine

The current Russia and Ukraine conflict poses a threat to economy, peace and security in Eurasia and the entire world.

The AFM International Presidents' Summit condemns the use of deadly armed force to resolve disputes that can be resolved through diplomatic intervention and dialogue. It is in this regard AFM International calls for the immediate end to the current armed hostilities.

We appeal for the de-escalation of the current conflict between Russia and Ukraine. We are of the view that the 2015 Minsk agreement provides a road map to a peaceful resolution of the longstanding tensions in the region.

We make an appeal for the protection of human lives and communities threatened by this violence.

We urge all AFM communities around the world to observe a special moment of prayer for God's intervention in this conflict.
